Dear Judges Wickham and Pomeroy:

I'm perplexed by Mr. Bricklin's letter of this afternoon. He indicates North Bay's Reply brief is untimely. It was served prior to noon today, one court day prior to the hearing set for tomorrow consistent with Local Rule 5(b)(2).

He also indicates it is unfairly prejudicial to his client's and should have been filed as part of the initial joint motion. Other than vague references to it being inaccurate and new factual allegations, he identifies nothing specific that he believes is inappropriate.
